MI : Merit Index is 80% of the average of Top Ten Scores in the respective IOQ 2021-22 Part I (NSE). All students scoring equal to and above MI are shortlisted for evaluation of their IOQ 2021-22 Part II (INO).

MAS : Minimum Admissible Score is 50% of the average of Top Ten Scores. No students below MAS is shortlisted for evaluation of IOQ 2021-22 Part II (INO). However students between MAS and MI may and may not be shortlisted. This depends upon which state he/she belongs to.
